Subject: Approval of Sale and Use of DeVILBISS TEKNA Pro and TEKNA ProLite Spray Guns in the Placer County Air Pollution Control District

Dear Mr. Hofert:

District staff have reviewed your request for approval to sell and use the non-HVLP, DeVILBISS TEKNA Pro and TEKNA ProLite Spray Guns.

Conditional approval is granted to sell and operate these spray guns in Placer County as other equivalent application coating method pursuant to PCAPCD Rule 234, Automotive Refinishing Operations, Section 303.5.

1. This approval is only valid for these spray guns if the air pressure supplied to the gun is equal to or less than the stated for each gun below:

TEKNA Pro Spray Gun with TE10 air cap	35 psig
TEKNA ProLite Spray Gun with TE10 air cap	35 psig
TEKNA Pro Spray Gun with TE20 air cap	26 psig
TEKNA ProLite Spray Gun with TE20 air cap	26 psig

2. A pressure gauge shall be attached to each spray gun and be in good working order whenever the spray gun is in operation.
3. The spray gun body and the air caps shall be clearly labeled by the manufacturer identifying the spray gun model and air cap model. This approval is invalid for any spray gun or cap where the label is not readable.
4. Any modification to the spray gun or pressure gauge shall invalidate this approval unless the modification is approved by the Placer County Air Pollution Control District.
